Each Learning Zone will also be linked to a particular House for our tutorial system to further support our care and guidance for students.

### **Top Features for students**

#### **An iconic State of the Art Theatre**

A State of the Art Theatre which will enable us to showcase and celebrate our Performing Arts and School shows. The Theatre will also be a multi functional space, as it will be a learning space for Drama as well as an exam hall and a facility for Community use. The entrance to the theatre will have a Box Office feel and there will be a café in the main reception where people will be able to sit and enjoy refreshments during the interval of shows.

#### **Collaborative Learning Zones**

There will be large, open and flexible collaborative Learning Zones which will enable a range of different types of learning to support our whole curriculum. The Learning Zones provide a 'buzzy' area where students can meet and socialise in a morning and sit, eat and relax, or check their emails. There are spaces for student to work collaboratively in small groups or large groups as well as providing the space to use specialist IT equipment relevant to the Learning Zone. As you move through to the far end of the Learning Zone there will a quiet and reflective area where students can evaluate, research and access specialist resources in a Learning Resource Area.

#### **Sporting facilities**

There will a brand new sports hall facility for students which will enable a vast range of indoor sports as well as a fitness suite to encourage students to use this activity outside of school hours. The external sports facilities have also been enhanced to ensure that all sport can be done including a full sized athletics track and rugby space.

#### **State of the Art technology**

State of the Art technology runs throughout the scheme. Students are particular excited about having their own individual laptop! The use of technology anytime, anywhere, will become a reality and ensure our students are at the cutting edge of IT developments to prepare them for their next steps.
